## **Summer Camp Health & Safety Precautions**

Hope Academy is excited about our Summer Camp and childcare program. We know that parents need childcare, and students need interaction with their peers and a sense of security and normalcy. We hope to fill both of those needs while keeping your child safe and engaged. Thank you for trusting us with your child.

## **HEALTH & SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:**

- Limited class/group sizes to match current social distancing, group gathering recommendations.
  CAPACITY: PK2 and PK3-max 10 each; PK4-max 15 per group; K-6-max 10 per group indoors/20 outdoors
- Classes/Groups will not share indoor spaces with other classes/groups, unless they are 6 feet apart. They will each have a designated classroom, designated bathroom, and designated entry/exit point to limit cross-contamination as much as possible.
- Staff will be specially trained for health precautions to limit the spread of contagions prior to the start of camp.
- Children will be trained/taught in proper handwashing procedures as well as other safety precautions such as keeping their hands away from their faces.
- All campers and staff members will be required to wash their hands upon entry.
- Hard, shared surfaces such as tables, doorknobs, sinks, etc. will be disinfected multiple times each day.
- Only camp/school employees and camp attendees(children) are permitted indoors and only camp/school employees are permitted within 6 feet of campers and school/camp employees.
- Drop off and pick up procedures will ensure limited contact between campers and employees. All students and staff will be screened for symptoms daily before or upon entry. No student or staff member who reports or presents any symptoms of any contagious illness will be permitted to attend camp.
- We are REQUIRING temperature checks upon arrival for children and staff members.
  - If a child or staff member has a temperature above 100.0 F (ages 3-10) or 99.7 (adults) they will be sent home.

YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY IS OUR TOP PRIORITY. We will adjust our camp procedures as necessary in response to any changes in recommendations from local, state, and/or national agencies. This may include loosening or tightening safety standards as appropriate. Parents will be notified of changes.
