



Scholarship Purpose:

The purpose of the scholarship program is to increase student enrollment in the middle school grades (6-8) while attracting a diverse group of distinguished students who exhibit exemplary scholastic, leadership, athletic, and artistic talents, thus promoting the vision that Hope Academy is a school that provides excellence in education in and beyond the classroom.

Criteria for Consideration:

- 1. Applicant must be an entering 6th, 7th, or 8th grade student during the 2021-2022 school year.
- 2. Applicant must submit a completed application with all supporting documentation by July 1,2021.
- 3. Applicant must be committed to completing one full academic year at Hope Academy. (Families who anticipate a move during the school year will not be eligible for scholarships.)
- 4. Must be a U.S. Citizen.

Scholarship Obligations:

- 1. Students must maintain at least a 85/ B average in all courses.
- 2. Students must not pose discipline problems in or outside of school.
- 3. Families must pay a registration fee of \$400, and any remaining tuition balance as outlined in their contract through FACTS online payment platform.
 - a. Monthly payments may be arranged for the remaining balance.
- 4. Guardians must provide transportation to and from school daily.
- 5. Guardians must attend all requested conferences.
- 6. Students and guardians must adhere to all policies and procedures set forth in the Hope Academy Contract and Handbook.

Selection and Notification Process:

A rubric will be used to award points based on six (6) standards. The application, supporting documents, reference checks, interviews, and other information will be used to determine points earned.

Scholarship announcements will be made in early Spring. Scholarships will be awarded on a first come, first served basis until all middle school seats are filled to capacity or by July 1, 2021.

Scholarship Application Checklist

Applicants must submit items 1-6. Items 7 and 8 are optional and must be submitted with the original packet. Information may be dropped off at the Hope Academy office in Florence Gardens or mailed directly to Hope Academy.

Required Documents:

- 1. Completed application
- 2. Copy of the most recent report card
- 3. Copy of most recent standardized test scores (if unavailable, HA will provide an assessment for completion)
- 4. Three letters of personal reference in sealed envelopes
- 5. Signed Release of Information form
- 6. Essay
 - Respond to the prompt: "Explain why you want to attend Hope Academy. Describe the talents, skills, and/or strengths you possess that make you the best student to receive this scholarship."
 - Essay should be 500 words or less, typed, double spaced, and 12-point Times New Roman font.

7. Resume

- List all extracurricular activities such as clubs, art/music/drama lessons, memberships, etc.
- For each extracurricular activity include the:
 - number of years of participation.
 - o level of participation (recreational, competitive, national, regional, etc.).
 - o related skills or responsibilities (point guard, captain, president, lead role, etc.).
 - o organization/league (Wings, SMSC, Lyman Youth Football, Boy Scouts of America, etc.).
 - o coach or sponsor's name and contact information.

Optional Supporting Documentation

- 8. Portfolio of work for consideration of artistic ability, including visual displays or recordings of performing arts.
- 9. Verification of community service
